

LEADER: Trosolwg o'r Prosiect

Rheolir Arloesi Mon (AM) ac Arloesi Gwynedd Wledig (AGW) gan Menter Môn, a benodwyd gan Lywodraeth Cymru fel y corff gweinyddol ar gyfer rhaglen LEADER yr UE yn Ynys Môn a Gwynedd. Lleolir y timau yn Llangefni a Phorthmadog, ac maent yn gweithio gyda gwahanol gymunedau o ddiddordeb, i ddatblygu a gweinyddu prosiectau arloesol a gweithgareddau peilot mewn ymateb i'r heriau sy'n wynebu'r economi wledig.

Sefydlwyd AM ac AGW yn 2015 i frandio gweithgareddau'r Grwpiau Gweithredu Lleol ar gyfer LEADER yn y ddwy sir. Sefydlwyd y Grwpiau Gweithredu Lleol i fonitro a rheoli'r rhaglenni yn lleol. Mae 20 aelod yn cynrychioli gwahanol fuddiannau a sectorau ym mhob Sir, gyda chyfrifoldeb am ddarparu cyfeiriad strategol a mewnbwn profiadol i brosiectau.

Ariennir y rhaglenni drwy raglen Cymunedau Gwledig Llywodraeth Cymru - Rhaglen Datblygu Gwledig Cymru 2014-2020, a ariennir gan Lywodraeth Cymru a Chronfa Amaethyddol Ewrop ar gyfer Datblygu Gwledig (EAFRD). Mae hefyd yn cael ei ariannu'n rhannol gan yr Awdurdod Datgomisiynu Niwclear (NDA) a Chyngor Gwynedd, ac Ymddiriedolaeth Elusennol Ynys Môn.

Nod Menter Môn yw bod ar flaen y gad o ran adnabod, defnyddio a chefnogi unigolion, busnesau a chymunedau i fabwysiadu technolegau digidol newydd er budd yr economi wledig. Mae'r cwmni'n parhau i archwilio cyfleoedd digidol ar draws y rhanbarth, mewn partneriaeth â gwahanol sefydliadau megis Microsoft, Awdurdodau Lleol, M-SParc, Llywodraeth Cymru, Grŵp Llandrillo Menai a Bwrdd Uchelgais Economaidd Gogledd Cymru. Hyd yn hyn mae prosiect wedi cynnwys cyflwyno LoRaWAN, Internet of Things (IoT), WiFi Cymunedol a dadansoddi data, Teledu WhiteSpace (TVWS), 'Artificial Intelligence' (AI) a Chynhwysiant Digidol. Disgwylir i'r swyddog digidol arwain ar rai o'r prosiectau digidol presennol, yn ogystal ac archwilio a datblygu cyfleoedd a phrosiectau newydd.

LEADER: Project Overview

Arloesi Mon (AM) and Arloesi Gwynedd Wledig (AGW) is managed by Menter Mon, appointed by Welsh Government as the administrative body for the EU LEADER programme in Ynys Môn and Gwynedd. The teams are located in Llangefni and Porthmadog, and works with various communities of interest, to develop and administer innovative projects and pilot activities in response to the challenges facing the rural economy.

AM and AGW were established in 2015 to brand the activities of the Local Action Groups for LEADER in both counties. The Local Action Groups have been established to monitor and manage the programmes locally. There are 20 members representing different interests and sectors in each County, with a responsibility for providing strategic direction and experienced input to projects.

The programmes are funded through the Welsh Government's Rural Communities program - Wales Rural Development Program 2014-2020, funded by the Welsh Government and the European Agricultural Fund for Rural Development (EAFRD). It is also part funded by the Nuclear Decommissioning Authority (NDA) and Gwynedd Council, and the Isle of Anglesey Charitable Trust.



Menter Mon aims to be at the forefront in identifying, deploying and supporting individuals, businesses and communities to adopt new digital technologies for the benefit of the rural economy. The company continues to explore digital opportunities across the region, in partnership with various organisations such as Microsoft, Local Authorities, M-SParc, Welsh Government, Grwp Llandrillo Menai and the North Wales Economic Ambition Board. To date initiatives have included the introduction of LoRaWAN, Internet of Things (IoT), Community WiFi & data analytics, TV WhiteSpace (TVWS), Artificial Intelligence and Digital Inclusion. The digital officer will be expected to lead on existing digital projects, explore and develop new opportunities and projects.
