

MÔN a MENAI



Môn a Menai aims to enable local communities to improve their local green spaces. By supporting local action, the initiative aims to transform residential areas into more attractive places to live, work and visit. It aims to boost local biodiversity, encourage volunteering activities, and enhance access to the countryside. Ultimately Môn a Menai aims to enable a greater sense of community wellbeing, empower communities to improve the quality of their local surroundings, develop a greater appreciation of their local area and a stronger connection with the natural environment.

Support is available to fund both environmental improvement works and training and development of volunteers. In terms of the scale of support, the Scheme supports environmental improvement works up to a value of £30,000 and volunteer development to a value of £3,500.

The Scheme will focus on six community projects, to be selected through an open application process across Anglesey and part of Arfon in Gwynedd. The scheme is funded through the Enabling Natural Resource and Wellbeing in Wales Grant Fund (EnRaW) and coordinated by Menter Môn.
