Cwlwm Seiriol - The Cwlwm Seiriol project has been developed to create opportunities for people living in the Seiriol Ward in south-east Anglesey to connect with the natural environment. The purpose of the programme is to enable communities to make constructive and sustainable changes to their local natural environment and promote biodiversity, health and wellbeing.



Môn a Menai - The project will support a maximum of 10 projects across Anglesey and Arfon. The scheme will encourage community well-being by improving community green spaces, as well as offering volunteering activities and training.



Menai Rivers - The scheme contributes to conserving and raising awareness of the biodiversity of rivers on either side of the Menai Strait, with the focus on conserving the endangered water vole.



The post will support one or more of the above projects, tasks will vary according to project requirements but may include:

- Co-ordinating and facilitating volunteer and/or training sessions
- Promoting, assessing and creating connectivity between different walking routes
- Working with external partners and stakeholders
- Promoting the environmental work through Menter Môn social media pages
